

- 4 year old Budgerigar
- History: Attacked by housecat; presented with degloving wound of RIGHT leg
- Other treatments: bandaging (after laser); oral antibiotics and anti-inflammatories

Degloving Wound in a Parakeet



Before Treatment

- Laser Therapy: 1W for total dosage of 62 joules over a 8cm² area (7J/cm²)
- Treatment Frequency: Twice weekly for 2 weeks, then once weekly for 2 weeks (6 treatments total)
